PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

It is a privilege to be selected to participate in the Girls Junior Northstars basketball program and I understand I am representing my family, school, community and teammates. As such I am held to a higher standard than non participants and commit to follow this code of conduct. I understand that violation of any of the requirements listed below can lead to disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the program.

1. Academics are a player's first priority; players will strive to succeed academically while making the commitment to participate in practices and games for my team.
2. Any reported disciplinary issues at school will effect playing time and continued participation in the program must be reviewed.
3. Players must always adhere to the positive aspects of the sports (i.e. fair play) and never condone violations of the game rules, behavior contrary to the spirit of the rules of the game, or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
4. Players must consistently display high standards of behavior.
5. Players will abstain from usage of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs and expect an environment that prohibits their use.
6. Players must appreciate the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
7. Players will not use any form of profanity.
8. Players must respect the rights, dignity, and worth of each and every person involved in the sport.
9. Players will respect and treat their teammates positively both on and off the court.
10. Players must accept responsibility for their own behavior and performance, and not argue with the game officials.
11. Players will not refuse to abide by an official's decision, or perform a verbal forceful or disrespectful demonstration of dissent to an official's decision.
12. Players will not engage in an abusive verbal attack, including "trash talking" or taunting, to any officials, participant, coach, team representative, or spectator.
13. Players will not engage in a physical attack, including but not limited to, the laying of a hand upon, pushing, shoving, or kicking of any officials, participant, coach, team representative or spectator.
14. Players will not use deliberately rough tactics during a game against an opponent in an attempt to injure said opponent.
15. Players will do their best to remember that youth sports are suppose to be FUN, and that winning and losing are part of everyone's experience.
